



Standard Quote Criteria

Conditions in respect of fixing and foundation

- Flat, loadbearing, pressure, and tensile-resistant contact surfaces at the attachment points, for direct bolting and lateral bracing, along the entire height.
- Necessary foundation +0/-15 mm, for frost-free and loadbearing depth. The concrete must be sufficiently dry to allow for the use of mechanical anchors.
- Foundations must always be made allowing sufficient edge distances for mechanical anchors.
- All final elevation points must be clearly visible, and measurable using a standard 10 m measuring tape on the nearest contact surface, at all our bracing and attachment points.
- All supporting surfaces must be in place at the time of installation and at a distance of +0/-15 mm.
- In the case of non-pre-designed blocks, spacers, counter nuts, spacer plates, through-tubes or counter-lays, Weland disclaims liability for all consequences thereof. This includes new distances, bearing capacity, stability, movement, water penetration, moisture, distortions, cracks, deformations, noise, and appearance. The same applies to any displacement or alternative placement of pre-designed bracing and attachment points.
- We reserve the right, at any time and regardless of the drawing, to supplement with additional bracing or supports if necessary for the purposes of strength or stability.

Conditions in respect of regulations, authority processing, contract limits, drawing approval, and quality assurance

- It is the responsibility of you, the developer or consultant, to obtain the requisite permission to establish the proposed facility, as well as to investigate which regulations apply to the project in question.
- All authority processing falls outside the scope of Weland's contract.
- Weland's contract limit extends from the underside of footing(s)/stair foot to the back of the landing, steps, or the top of the stringer.
- Any static calculations are excluded unless otherwise stated in our quote.
- Weland standard static calculations with reactions up to supports can be offered for an additional price (calculation of supports excluded).
- Weland may not act as a supplier to a static project from a certified structural engineer.
- Where the product is to be used in construction class KK2 or higher, you as the customer must contract the services of a certified structural engineer to prepare static documentation.

Construction documentation A(x), project documentation B(x), static project static control report, etc., as well as authority processing, do not fall under the scope of Weland's contract, regardless of whether or not the product is placed in a construction class.

- For orders with approval, a workshop drawing is included. Any revisions will be subject to an additional charge.
- Normally, drawings must be approved within 1-5 working days, in order to meet the agreed delivery time.
- Unless otherwise stated in Weland's order confirmation, quality assurance consists solely of the Weland standard certificate.

Conditions in respect of delivery and/or installation carried out by Weland

- Necessary unloading space, as well as a road capable of taking a 12 tonne truck to the unloading point or the installation location for selected installation.
- If a 12 tonne truck cannot get to the installation site, time and material will be charged, according to alternative methods.
- Costs must be expected for pallets and pallet collars.
- If you want Weland to book transport, unloading assistance using a forklift or similar is required.
- Where optional installation has been selected, unobstructed space conditions for material and installation tools, as well as access to power for connecting work tools, must be provided.
- Installation is only available in Zealand, Lolland and Falster, and measurement is only available with a purchase that includes installation.
- Unless otherwise stated, surveying, installation, and mounting bolts for floors and walls are not included.
- The products are supplied in separate parts for bolt installation.
- All deliveries are subject to Weland's sale and supply terms and conditions.

Payment terms

- Our standard terms of payment are net cash and apply unless otherwise confirmed by us.
- 30 days net may be agreed upon the issuance of a bank guarantee or with sufficient FICO credit max = 2% of the company's equity capital in case of surplus, or 0% in case of deficit. Therefore, no credit is given in the event of a negative net profit.
- Stated prices are net in DKK and exclusive of VAT.
- Unless otherwise stated, prices are based on today's level and apply for 40 working days from the date of the quote.
